Lenora "Sallye" Lynn, 81, died Fri. Oct. 9, 1992, in a Beckley hospital, following a long illness.

Born Mar. 5, 1911, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Ira Howard Miller and Lula Bartgis.

Mrs. Lynn lived most of her life in Hinton. She was a former employee of the U.S. government, who worked in the Pentagon during World War II, and was a member of the First Baptist Church.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Lyman D. Lynn, on Dec. 4, 1968; and an infant sister, Martha Miller.

Survivors include a brother, James Lewis Miller of Marietta, Oh.; three sisters, Mary Marguarite Dillon of Hinton, Mamie Lloyd Phillips of Ceredo-Kenova and Frances Elizabeth Cale of Harrisonburg, Va.
