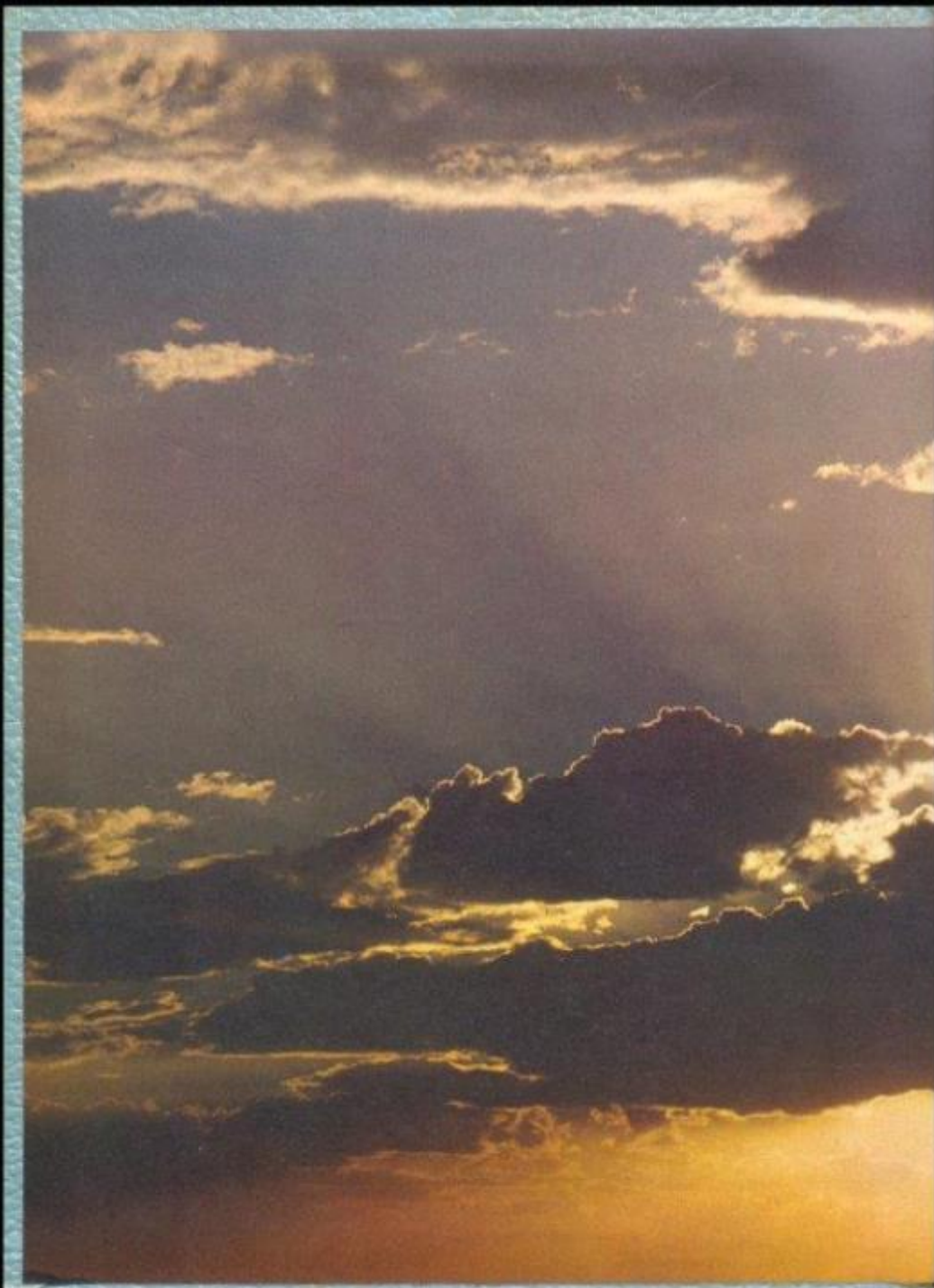

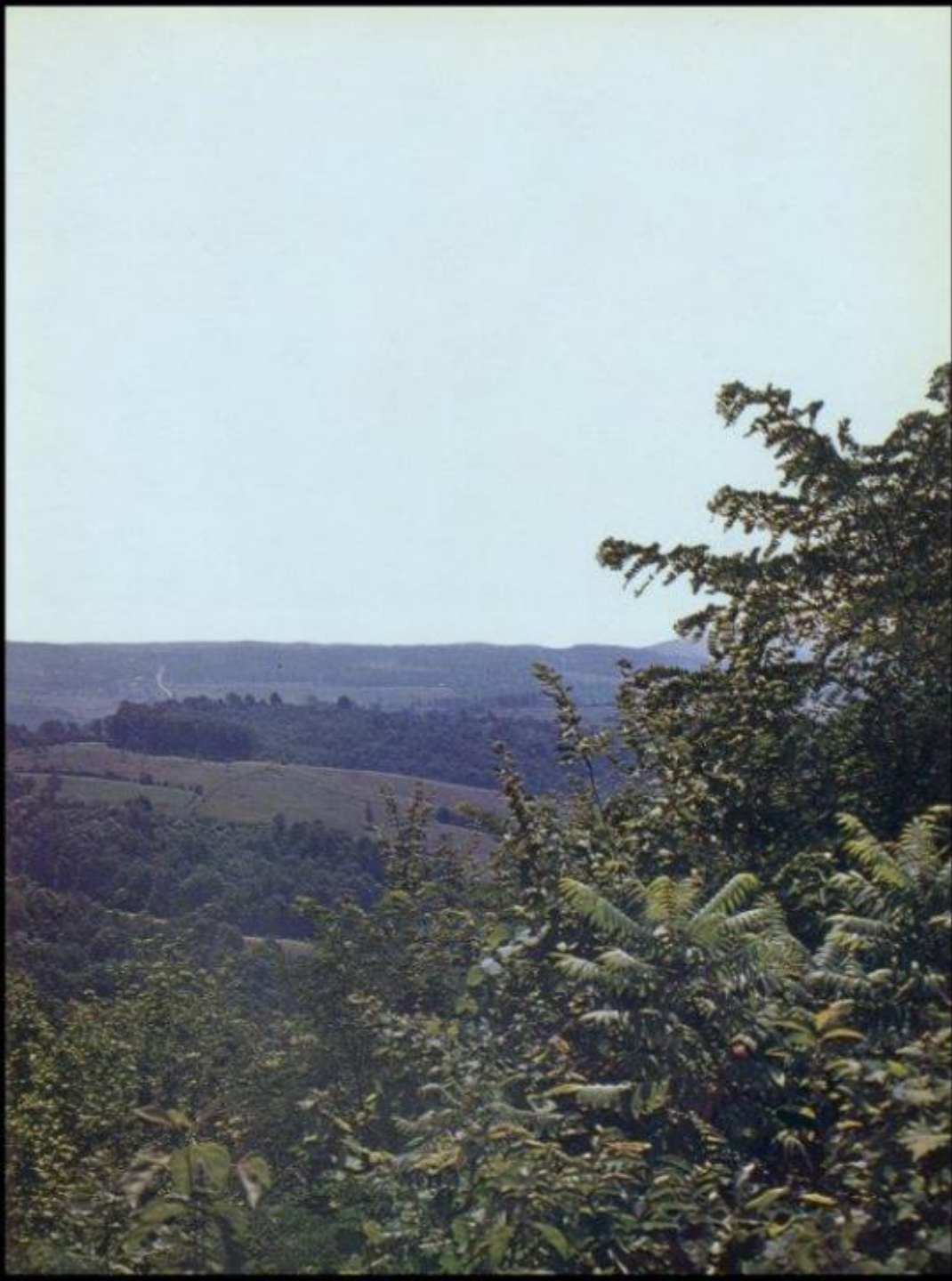
The Spotlight Focuses on Hinton High School

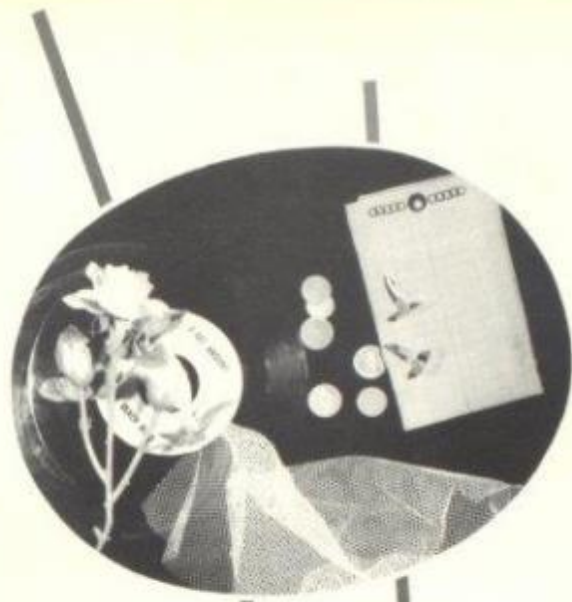

The Hinton High Bobcats started their season with a bang against Cowen. Hinton won by a lopsided 39-7 score. The 'Cats chewed up 364 yards, and 13 first downs; to only 146 yards and 2 first downs for the Bulldogs. Most of Hinton's scores came on long runs. DeWitt scored on runs of 13 and 27 yards, and a 37 yard pass. D. K. Porterfield scored on runs of 30 & 75 yards, while Bob "Madcat" Williams put the defense on the scoreboard with a 48 yard pass interception score.

Stoco

The second game was tougher as the Bobcats met the Stoco Indians. The first score was set up on a 47 yard run to the one by C. W. Rodes. The second score came in the second quarter on a 47 yard pass from Eddie Yates to C. W. Rodes. In the third quarter DeWitt scored on a 2 yard run. The final score of the game was 20-6 in favor of the Bobcats.



Peterstown

Hinton had an even tougher game with Peterstown. Peterstown was one of the toughest teams that the 'Cats played even though the Pirates had a disappointing season. The 'Cats scored once each in the second and fourth quarters, but defense was the key factor. The score was 13-0.

Fayetteville

In their fourth contest the Bobcats journeyed to Fayetteville for an encounter with the Pirates. This game was mostly an offensive battle with the 'Cats coming out on top--42-20. Hinton scored five touchdowns in the first half while holding the Pirates scoreless.



Mount Hope

The Bobcats traveled to Mt. Hope where they suffered their defeat of the season. The 'Cats just couldn't get going and failed to control the strong Mt. Hope team. The final score was 25-13.



Princeton

The Tigers of Princeton came to Hinton for the Bobcat's homecoming. The 'Cats won the game by a decisive 33-0 score. The Bobcat defense did a great job. Time after time the Tigers would put on a drive and be stopped short of the goal line. The first quarter was played in as little time as possible, as the clock did not stop even once. The scoring for the 'Cats was done by DeWitt, Potterfield and Rhodes. An oddity of the game was that Hinton had only 10 first downs to the Tiger's 12. However, Hinton had 360 yards total offense, and the Tigers had only 174.



Shady Spring

The Bobcats kept their title hopes alive by downing a strong Shady team. The 'Cats were behind at the half by 14-12, and they came from behind to win by a score of 33-20.



Oak Hill

The Bobcats barely escaped with their tails against a spiteful, upset-minded Oak Hill team. The game ended with the Bobcats coming out on top with a 12-6 victory. It wasn't until the fourth quarter that the 'Cats scored the winning touchdown.



Gauley Bridge

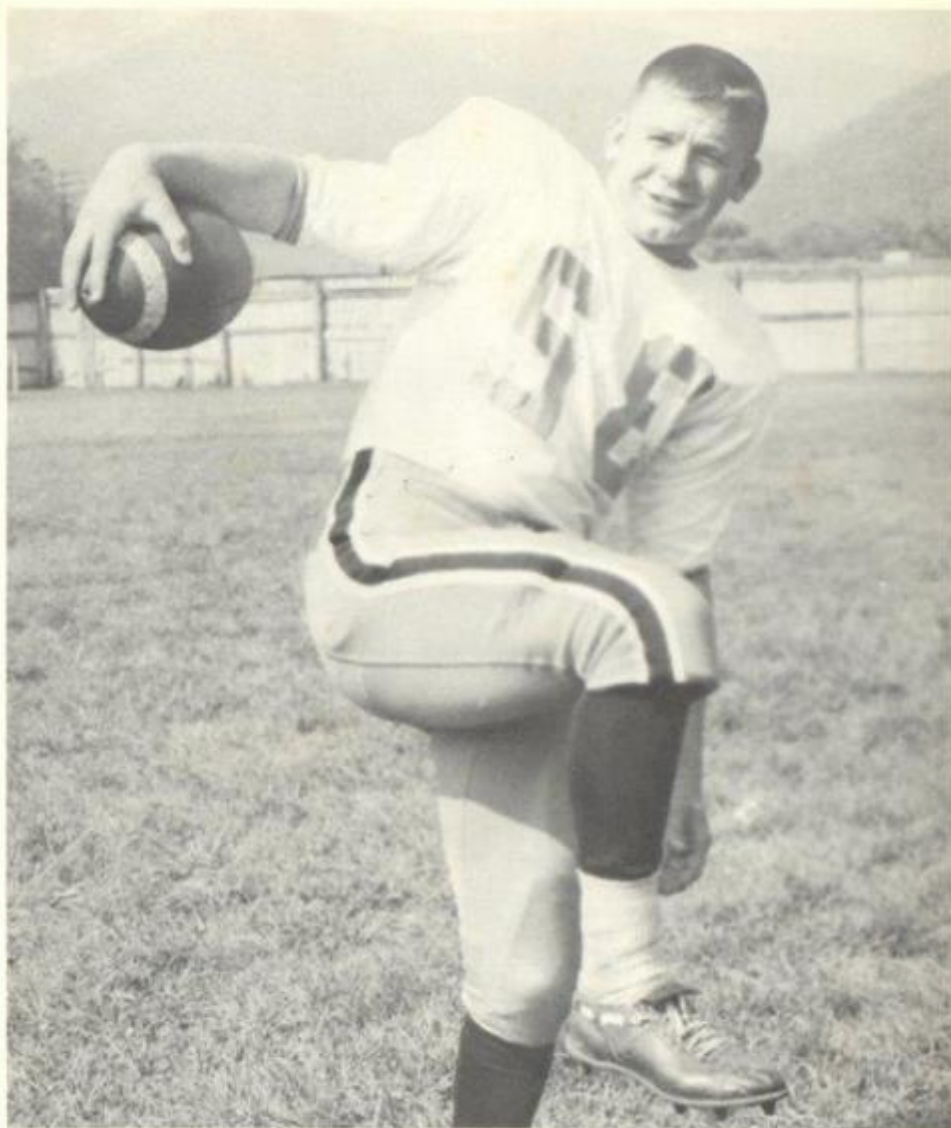

Beckley

Hinton's playoff dreams went down the drain when they met with the Flying Eagles of Beckley. The Bobcats gave the Eagles an even game but the breaks seemed to go for the Eagles, and they came out on top--20-0. Beckley's first score came on a blocked punt by Hindsley. He blocked DeWitt's punt and raced 55 yards for the score. The second score was set up on a partially blocked punt which was recovered by Beckley on the Hinton 32 yard line. Four plays later the Eagles scored. The half ended with the Eagles in front 13-0. The second half was played on even terms until Beckley scored again with 4:28 left in the game.
