

Margaret Bird Woodrum March 3, 1920 – September 7, 2022

Margaret Bird Woodrum of Nimitz, WV, died at Charleston, WV, September 7, 2022, following a short illness. Born March 3, 1920 at Dixie, WV, she was the daughter of the late Newman A. Bird and Susie Ramsey Bird. She was a graduate of Hinton High School and received her A.B. and B.S. degrees from Concord University. She and her husband owned and operated Woodrum's Store in Nimitz for many years. She taught in Summers County elementary schools, namely Ellison Ridge, White Oak, Jumping Branch, and she retired from Hinton High School in 1982, where she was an English teacher and choir director. After retirement she continued to be active in music by giving private piano lessons in her home.

She was a member of the Bellepoint Baptist Church for forty-seven years where she was pianist and organist, Sunday School teacher and youth worker. She then became a member of the Nimitz Baptist Church where she served as the organist and a member of the choir. She was a member of Gideons International Auxiliary, Beckley Camp, and has served as chaplain and president. She also served as a volunteer at the Appalachian Regional Hospital Continuous Care Unit in Hinton. She was a member of the Summers County Retired School Employees and a life member of Delta Zeta National Sorority.

Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Howard P. Woodrum, one daughter, Sara Lynn Massi, and a brother, Don M. Bird.
