



Charlotte “Toddy” Maynor Cheetham

Charlotte "Toddy" Maynor Cheetham, 89, passed away on Saturday, October 19th following a lengthy illness. She was a long time Hampton resident.

Charlotte was born in Maynor, WV on June 19, 1924 to Ira Jefferson and Mable Clausing Maynor. She was a 1941 graduate of Hinton High School. In 1943 she married Billy Joe Cheetham in San Diego, CA. They were married 36 years at the time of his death in 1980. Following her husband's passing, Mrs. Cheetham worked in the cafeteria at Jefferson Davis Middle School in Hampton, retiring in 1998.
