Harry C. Johnson, 66, of Buck Route, died Wednesday October 23 at 4:12 a.m. in a Roanoke, Va., hospital after a short illness.

Born Sept. 22, 1919, in Hinton, he was a son of the late Thomas and Laura Brabb Johnson.

Mr. Johnson had lived most of his life in Summers County, was a member of the Little Wolf Creek Baptist Church and was retired from the Chessie System working as a conductor. He was a member of the UTU and was a World War II veteran.
