We take one last look at Hinton and climb into our new ship. As we leave terra firma we think over the events of our visit and resolve not to wait as long to come back as we did this time.





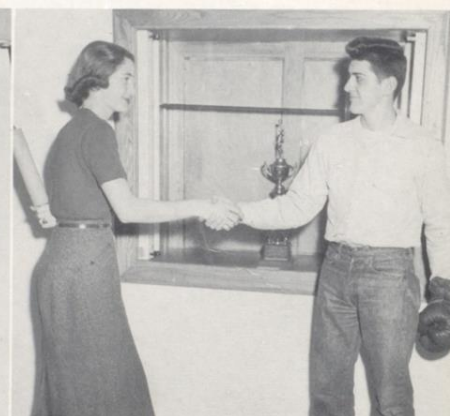
