### **MRS. CALDWELL, 28, DIES EARLY TODAY**

**Daughter of Mr. and Mrs.  
W. D. Foster Dies After  
Long Illness**

Mrs. Dorothy Foster Caldwell, 28 years old, wife of Edward Caldwell, died this morning at 5:30 o'clock at the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. W. D. Foster, on Main street, after an extended illness.

Born January 23, 1916 at Thurmond, she had resided most of her life in this city. She was a graduate of Hinton high school and had been a member of the Central Baptist church since a child.

Funeral arrangements were incomplete today.

Survivors include her husband, who is presently stationed with the United States Navy at Newport, Rhode Island; a son Harold Layne Caldwell, of this city; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. W. D. Foster, of this city; and three brothers, Pvt. William D. Foster, Jr., stationed with the United States Army at Camp Cooke, Calif., Harold Vernon Foster, with the United States Navy at Great Lakes, Ill., and Norval Lee Foster, of this city.
