Aubrey Lee Meadows, 59, of 18 Lincoln St., Beckley, died Sunday at 10:30 a.m. in a Bethesda, Maryland, hospital after long illness.

Born Feb. 11, 1922, in Hinton, he was a son of the late James Farfield and Janie Sims Meadows.

Mr. Meadows was a World War II veteran, a resident of Beckley since 1952, a member of the Beckley Regular Baptist Church.

He was employed by the A & T Tea Co. for 26 years before retiring and a member of the Food Store Employees Union.

Two brothers, Bernard Q. and James Meadows, preceded him in death.

Survivors include his wife, Eunice Arlene McKinney Meadows; a brother, Howard Jackson Meadows of Hinton, and two sisters, Miss Marie Meadows and Mrs. Anna Jean Marshall, both of Beckley.

Services were held Wednesday at 1 p.m. in the Melton Mortuary chapel in Beckley with the Revs. Bud Israel and Fred Dillon officiating. Burial allowed in the Blue Ridge Memorial Gardens in Prosperity.
