## Jane Jackson Moore

Jane Jackson Moore, 88, died on July 12 at Hilton Head Regional Medical Center of a cerebral hemorrhage.

Born May 11, 1919 in Hinton, WVA, Jane was a graduate of the University of Kentucky, where she earned a degree in

education. On August 25, 1941 she married Virgil Lytle Moore, Jr., who became an officer in the US Foreign Service, and together the couple lived in Switzerland; Senegal; Cameroon; Pakistan; Washington, DC; South Africa; Belgium; and Panama. They moved to Hilton Head Plantation when Virgil retired in November 1979.

A teacher all her life, Jane taught high school in Alexandria, VA, and grade school in Cameroon, Pakistan and Panama. She was a substitute at Hilton Head High School for many years, taught English as a Second Language, and also gave private lessons in French.

She was an active member of the First Presbyterian Church, where she was an elder. She served on the Missions Committee for 15 years and on the board of the First Presbyterian Day School, and faithfully attended Bible study classes.

Jane loved to travel and to visit her children in places as far-flung as Turkey, Russia, France, and, in the US, California, Oregon and Vermont. She loved the beach. She was also an avid reader and an enthusiastic bridge-player.

Jane is survived by Virgil, her husband of nearly 66 years; daughter Sally and her husband Robert Freedman of Princeton, NJ; daughter Lucy Moore of Danbury, CT; and daughter-in-law Kathryn Moore, whose husband Virgil Moore III died in 2003. She also has five grandchildren: Emily Jane Moren, Alix Moren, Benjamin Moren, Virgil Moore IV and Thomas Moore.
