## Of Bobcat Pride



On November 3, 1978, when the Bobcats defeated the Northfork Blue Demons 27-0, a half-century of unforgettable victories and disheartening defeats came to a close.

Avis Field was the original name of Stokes Stadium. The field was built by the C & O Railroad between 1900 and 1903. Early Hinton football teams played there without coaching or school backing. In 1912 the Hinton team acquired a coach making it an official High School team.

Avid field has seen many great games. Some thrillers include the 1937 9-7 victory over Charleston High School. That year the Bobcats were declared the West Virginia State Champions. In 1968 the Bobcats won the State AA Championship by defeating Oceana 9-0.

In 1963 Avis Field was renamed Stokes Stadium in honor of the late Dr. J.W. Stokes, team physician from 1935-1976 and "The Greatest Bobcat Fan."

Though Stokes Stadium will no longer exist after this season, no one will ever forget the pride and leadership displayed in that sports arena.
