Mrs. Nell Elizabeth Stennett, 71, of Stokes Drive, was dead on arrival Thursday, January 7, at a Hinton Hospital following an auto accident at Lowell, according to Deputy D. L. Keaton of the Summers County Sheriff's Department.

Born November 10, 1916, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Henry Lee and Sally Ann Sears Criddle.

Mrs. Stennett was a lifelong resident of Hinton, a retired employee of Pipestem State Park, retiring in 1977, and was a member of the First United Methodist Church at Hinton.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Raymond Stennett, on May 5, 1977; and a son, Raymond Lee Stennett, on November 3, 1940.

Survivors include a sister, Mrs. Bill (Jean) Taylor of Hinton; a brother, Howard Criddle of Baltimore, Maryland; and several nieces and nephews.

The body was cremated.

Memorial services were held Sunday January 10 at 2 p.m. at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors Chapel in Hinton with Rev. D. D. Elwell officiating.
