**MRS. ANNIE WEBB**  
**DIES IN HUNTINGTON**

Mrs. Annie Allen Webb, 36, of Huntington, wife of Ira Webb, died unexpectedly at her home Saturday night. Mrs. Webb had been in ill health for several months. She died in her sleep, and was found dead by her husband Sunday morning.

Mrs. Webb was born and reared in this county, and had lived most of her life in the Willow Wood section. She had resided in Huntington for the last 10 years.

Besides her husband she is survived by one son, Ira Webb, Jr., and a daughter, Fostena.

Also surviving are her father, J. H. Allen of near Willow Wood, and four brothers, L. B. Allen, Ralph H. Allen and Jack Allen, all of near Willow Wood and Charlie Allen of Richmond, Va.; and a sister, Mrs. Grace Persinger of Clayton.

The body will arrive here on No. 6 tonight and will be taken to the home of her brother, Jack Allen. Funeral services will be conducted at the Woodrumtown church Tuesday afternoon by the Rev. Claude Buckland. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.
